1	The Art-Lab for Human Rights and Dialogue	UNESCO and the OHCHR have developed the Art-Lab Framework for ethical artistic practices in support of human rights and dignity. The purpose of the Art-Lab programme geared by UNESCO is to support persons in vulnerable contexts to express their fundamental rights through the practice of the arts, respectful of cultural rights. Based on 87 documented ethical artistic practices, Art-Lab has identified basic ethical principles and practices to support the humanitarian and development operators in support of human rights and dignity recovery. The next pilots of Art-Lab will kake place: 1/1 in Centrafrique with women suffering violence, street children, refugees and displaced persons as well as Pygmees; 2/ in Cairo with regugees from Sudan. The Art- Lab workshop will train young people as facilitators of future Art-Lab projects with persons in emergency contexts.	5.
