
57 million

Women with primary and secondary education are far more likely to be aware of measures for preventing mother-to-child transmission of HIV2




Over the past four decades, the global increase in women's eduation has **prevented** more than 4 million child deaths




reduces involvement in conflict

That's 49% of the total number of children out of school.







Yet, only $\frac{2}{6}$ of all humanitarian aid goes into education.
